In order to receive the full award you will need to complete an additional ilm unit M301 (Solving problems and making decisions) which will help you to put the theory into practice. Your assignment will then be marked and you will be given feedback on the result, if you are successful your work will be submitted for ilm unit certification .

The full ILM Award is for practising or aspiring first line managers. The award has been specially designed to give candidates a solid foundation in their formal development as a manager. This course has also been contextualised to meet the specific needs of VCS staff and can be offered on a distant learning basis as well as being delivered through taught sessions.
